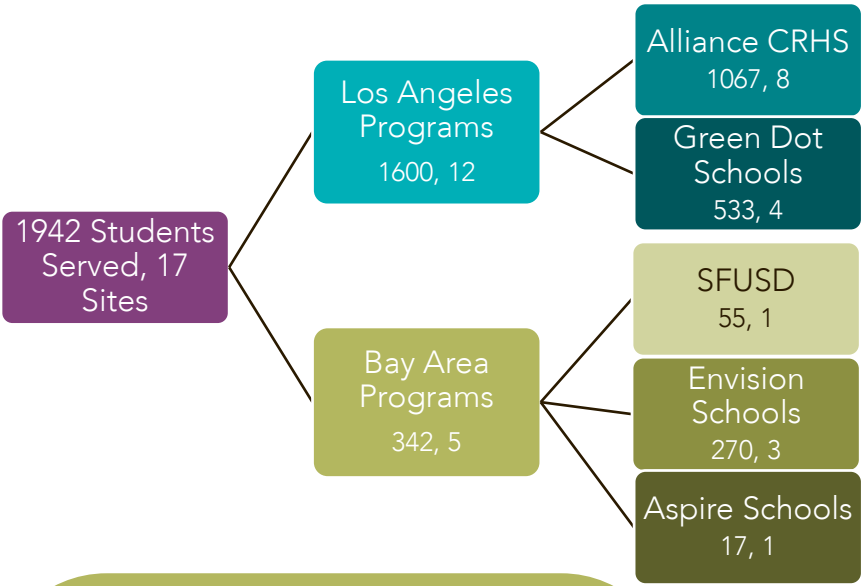

78% of sites were returners

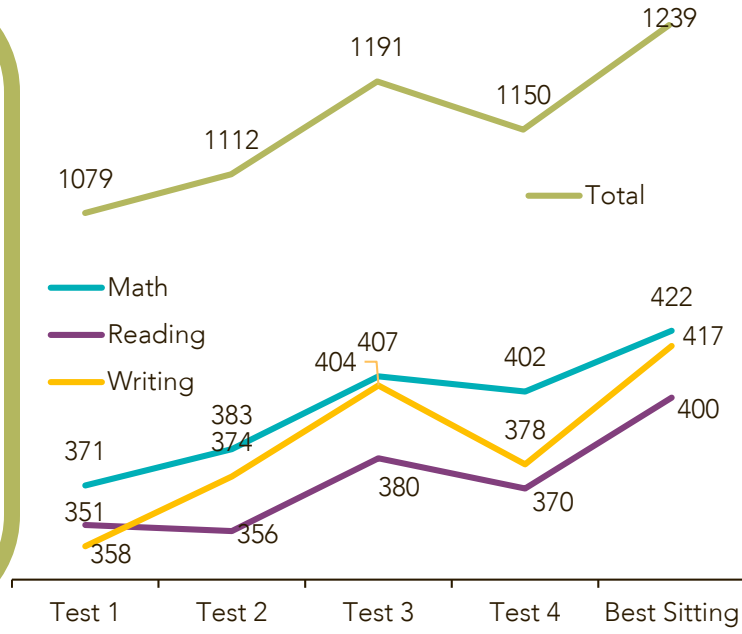
6 sites were returning for their 3rd academic year cycle

PROGRAM STATISTICS

CollegeSpring students' SAT scores improved **160 points** from baseline to best sitting.

Students improved **65 points** in math, **55 points** in reading, and **78 points** in writing.

By the end of the program, **2.4 times as many students** had a score of 1550 or above.



Outstanding Students

He... wants to pursue a degree in technology of engineering. He began to believe in himself a lot more... he was able to achieve a near 400 point improvement.

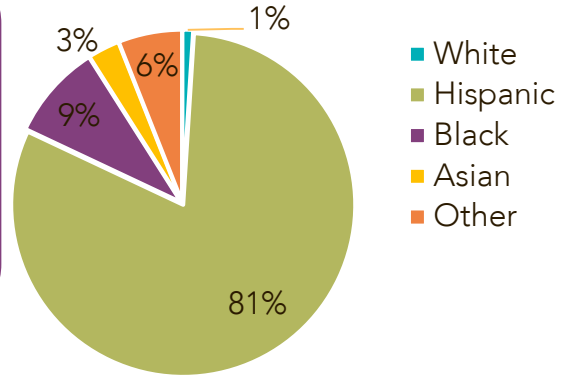
He went from not really thinking about college to asking me if his grades were okay for certain universities.



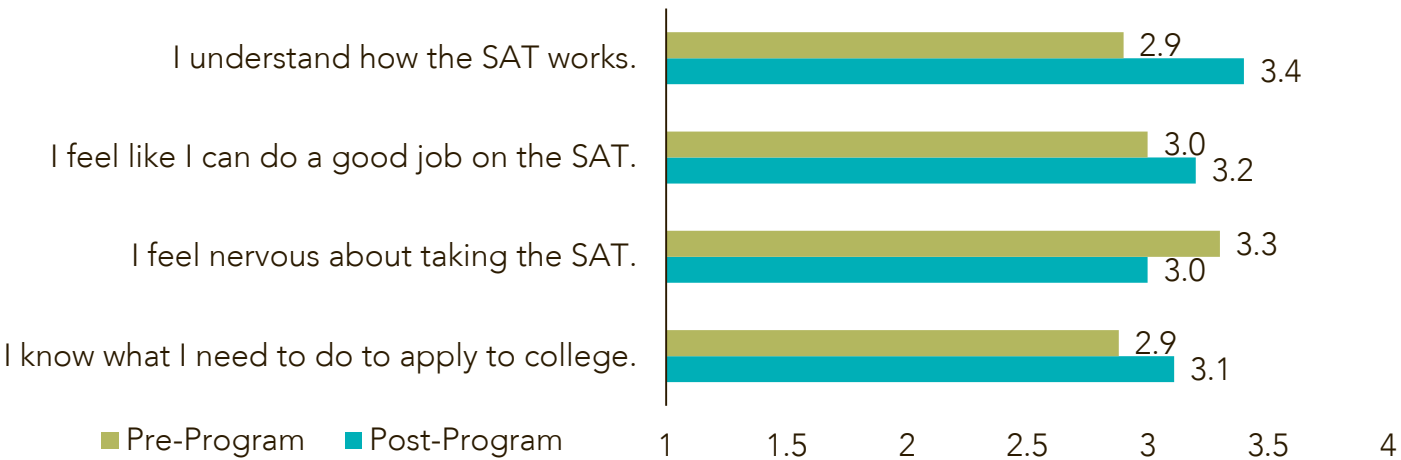
Who were our students?

- 50% speak English as a second language
- 39% do not have an English-speaking parent
- 81% are from immigrant parents
- 12% are immigrants
- 87% will be first-generation college students
- 63% received no help from their parents on SAT prep/CollegeSpring

Student Race/Ethnicity

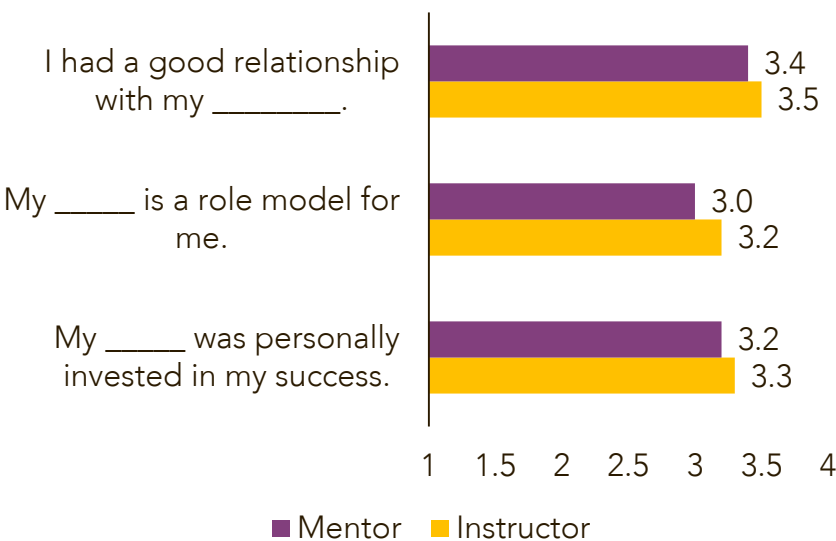


Student SAT and College Attitudes

84% of students said their SAT scores improved because of CollegeSpring

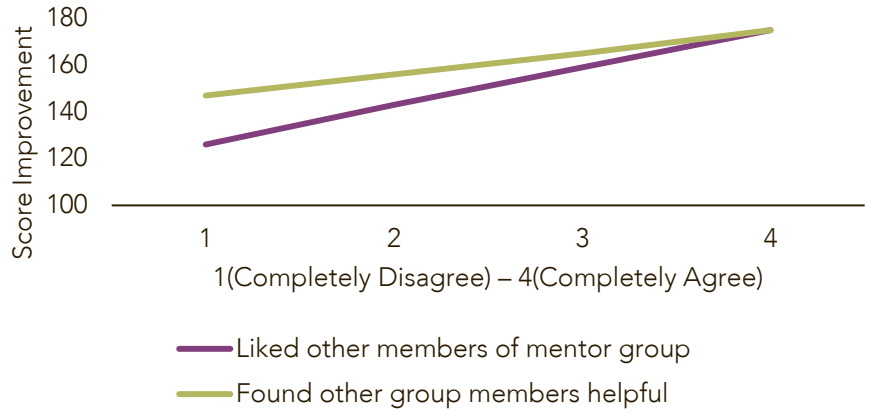
79% of students said they have a better chance of getting into college because of CollegeSpring

79% said the CollegeSpring program was a good use of their time

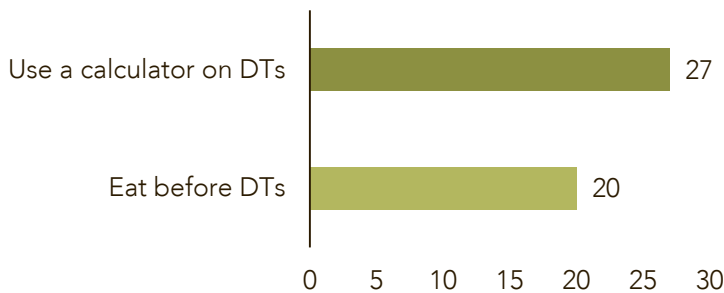
What did we learn this year?

The more students in mentoring groups liked and helped each other to learn, the more they improved their SAT scores.

Testing Behaviors & SAT Scores



Simple behaviors like using a calculator and having breakfast can have a big impact (20 – 27 points) on students' SAT scores.

Sophomores who go through CollegeSpring show significant score improvements.

Sophomore class #1 improved 195 points from baseline to best sitting; Sophomore class #2 improved 190 points.
