

Comparison Schools Report

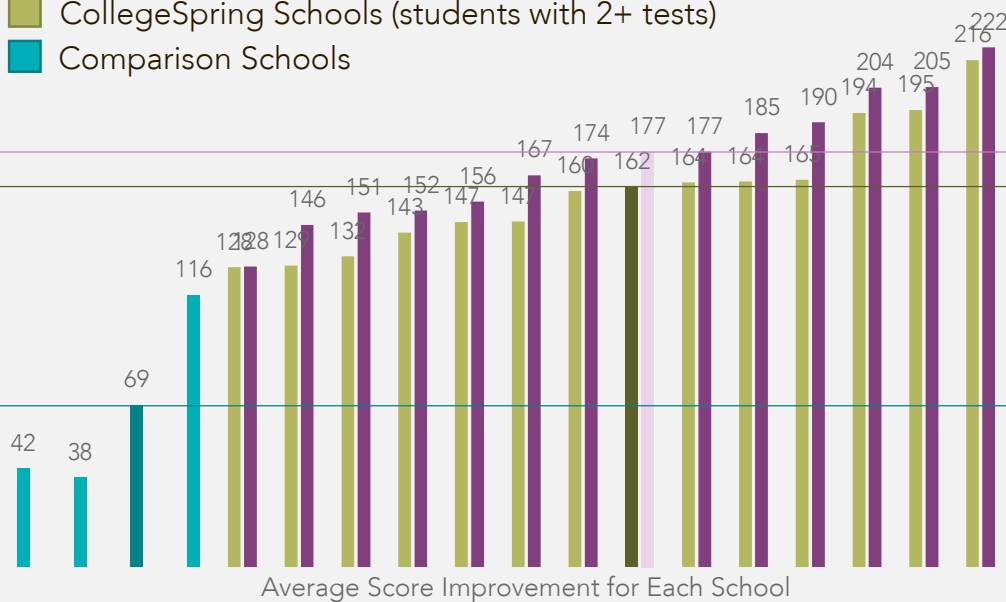
In AYP 2012 and 2014, 1 Alliance and 2 Green Dot schools ran CollegeSpring diagnostic tests without running the CollegeSpring instructional and mentoring program – “Comparison Schools.”

Students at Alliance and Green Dot who completed the CollegeSpring program in AYP 2012 and 2014 improved their SAT scores significantly more than students at Comparison Schools.

Average Score Improvement for All AYP 2012 and 2014 Schools

- CollegeSpring Schools (students with 4 tests)
- CollegeSpring Schools (students with 2+ tests)
- Comparison Schools



CollegeSpring 4-Test Average 177 pts

CollegeSpring 2+ Test Average 162 pts

Comparison 2+ Test Average 69 pts

Both CollegeSpring students who took all 4 diagnostic tests and students who took 2+ tests significantly out-performed students at Comparison Schools.

This indicates that, though diagnostic testing is important, it is not sufficient to generate the level of impact CollegeSpring has on students.
