



CollegeSpring has compiled a set of Best Practices that are related to maximizing student outcomes through strong CollegeSpring instructors.

Prior test prep experience is helpful, but the most important factors are instructor beliefs and attitudes.

Prior Teaching Experience

Instructors do not need experience teaching math, reading, or writing to be effective.

Instructors with prior experience teaching test prep tend to be particularly effective.

Beliefs and Attitudes

Whenever possible, instructors should opt-in to teach the program.

The most important characteristic is that instructors *believe* that their students can greatly improve their scores in the program.

The best instructors are enthusiastic about learning from CollegeSpring training.

Students with instructors who had positive attitudes about their ability to grow their scores and about teaching CollegeSpring saw 30+ additional points of improvement.
